

MANITOWISH WATERS PLANNING COMMISSION  
Hagemann CUP Public Hearing Minutes  
**June 6, 2017**  
Manitowish Waters Airport Terminal Building

Planning Commission Chair Dan Sleight called the hearing to order at 7:10 P.M.

Chairman Sleight read into the record the legal notice as posted May 23, 2017 and published as two insertions in the Lakeland Times.

Chairman Sleight called for testimony. The project was introduced by Tom Cote on behalf of the applicant. The applicant desires to construct a detached garage for personal storage, boats, and snowmobiles as the current garage does not contain sufficient room. Proposed location is next to the current garage and the building would be no larger than 32x34 feet. The building would be sided to match the house, with windows, similar to the existing garage.

Marilyn Wittry: Not opposed to the construction of a garage, but just to its location. The view passing down the street would be a 3 car garage, a 2 car garage, the house, and then a shed. The proposed plan would require the removal of a number of large trees and excavation. Mrs. Wittry provided photographs and proposed an alternative location at the site of an existing volleyball court.

Neighboring landowners were mailed written notification of the application and hearing. The Zoning office did not receive any correspondence relative to the application.

Chairman Sleight called three times for further accessory. None give.

Chairman Sleight declared the hearing closed at 7:21 P.M.
