

MANITOWISH WATERS PLANNING COMMISSION  
Vogel CUP Public Hearing Minutes  
**June 6, 2017**  
Manitowish Waters Airport Terminal Building

Planning Commission Chair Dan Sleight called the hearing to order at 7:00 P.M.

Chairman Sleight read into the record the legal notice as posted May 23, 2017 and published as two insertions in the Lakeland Times.

Chairman Sleight called for testimony. The project was introduced by applicant Bill Vogel. The 40x60 metal sided and roofed garage will be used for personal vehicle use, including a motor home. One of the existing garages will be removed from the site. Sidewall height will be 16 feet and roof mean height will be 22.4 feet. The building will be built 20 feet from the side lot line. The property has been recently surveyed so the lot line is known. The 40 foot long motor home may require trees to be removed to allow for maneuvering. The location was chosen to minimize impact on neighbors. It is 150 feet from the lot line to the nearest neighbor's driveway, and the area in between forested. The building will be minimally visible from the road. It will have Tudor brown sides and evergreen trim.

Neighboring landowners were mailed written notification of the application and hearing. The Zoning office did not receive any correspondence relative to the application.

Chairman Sleight called three times for further accessory. None give.

Chairman Sleight declared the hearing closed at 7:10 P.M.
