AUGUST ROAD REPORT

The preliminary mowing of town road sides has been completed. There still are areas where secondary mowing will be required. The brushing and trimming of tree limbs is still an ongoing process.

On Cook's Cove Rd. to help meet with town road standards trees have been removed and portions of the road made wider. It is still in process with stumps yet to be ground and additional gravelling of the road.

At the garage we received an additional 200 cu. Yds of gravel.

Being that our park's employee is working on a part time basis as needed, we have taken over garbage details for all town parks and facilities.

The new 2018 Western Star chassis which we had ordered has been completed and has been delivered to TRUCK EQUIP. INC. for it's components and winter equipment to be installed. Completion time will be toward the end of October. It will replace our #2 patrol truck a 2006 International.

The sander of our outgoing #2 patrol truck was removed and retrofitted on the Airport's 1999 International truck to help assist with a better resale value. At an additional cost the old street sweeper will also be sold with it.

Now that the new Rest Lake Park boat ramp has been opened, the old launch has been barricaded off. It's DNR signage was removed and reinstalled at the new ramp. At the exit road of the new boat ramp a Stop sign was needed and it was installed.

At the Koller Park bathrooms we installed all new door handles and a dead bolt lock replacing the noncommercial types.
