OCTOBER ROAD REPORT

Our newly acquired Western Star patrol truck arrived on 10/26. In anticipation of it's arrival, the previous #2 patrol truck was delivered to the Airport. Prior to that it was given a thorough inspection. In doing so, the alternator, fan belts and two pulleys needed replacing. Along with that, lubrication and filters where also replaced. And then made winter ready.

We received a quote from Pitlick and Wick for a culvert replacement on Alder Lake Rd. south of Leasure Ln. for \$9400. And a quote for adding a runoff culvert (major pond on the road) near Cranberry Blvd. for \$9100.

Road salt was picked up from the Vilas County shed. Half which was mixed in with the 150 yds of sand already received. This now gives us 320 yds of sand/salt mix for immediate use. We are expecting and additional 150 yds of sand in the near future.

For the proposed future pickup purchase we received an additional quote for the truck chassis and one more for it's equipment.

All of our equipment has been made winter ready.

The buoys to the chain have been pulled. Along with the swim buoys and floats.

The Koller Park and the Playground bathrooms have been drained and winterized.

All the Koller Park picnic tables and wooden bike racks have been removed and placed in storage.

At the Transfer Station we still need "education" on what we can and cannot accept for disposal at the facility. Also need to know who is responsible (go to person) for the servicing of the compactors.
