## Airport Operations Report: June 2018

1) All runway lights, PAPI, and beacon tower are now operational.

Van Ert was called on 6/8 to check on the status of the runway lights, and PAPI system.

They had no idea that the PAPI system was inoperable, and were aware of runway light issues. Set up an appointment for 6/13 for a site visit.

After calling Van Ert, I investigated further into the PAPI-32 problem of tripping the circuit breaker during operation. I found loose wires on the PAPI-32 contactor in the terminal. Tightened wire connections. Tightened connections on contactor in electrical panel out on runway. On 6/11, notified Van Ert that PAPI-32 had been working for 3 days and may not need servicing on 6/13 visit.

On 6/13 Jim from Van Ert and myself replaced the circuit boards in 6 runway lights with circuit boards out of new spare lights.

One runway light was left in place which was originally tagged as damaged. It was operational, but it was much brighter than the other lights. On 6/21, I replaced that pc board.

I fixed 2 broken runway lights damaged during winter snow removal.

Beacon light is working after I replaced lamps with 2 used and cleaned lamps. No new spares in garage. New lamps on order. Closed NOTAM 06/214.

- 2) Replaced both stop signs by electronic gate entry. Old signs were badly cracked, and faded. Town crew provided signs.
- 3) Ongoing weekly mowing operations.
- 4) Owner of Hangar #15 announced he wanted to rent his hangar. Kept contact information. Passed onward to several pilots.
- 5) Red truck heater/ defroster blower problems. Replaced heater blower resistor. Blew sand, dust and leaves out of ducts and fan.

Reattached front valance back to bumper. Had been taped together. New emergency light is on order. Current light is very noisy while in operation. Speedometer is still inoperative. Have not investigated.
