JULY ROAD REPORT

The Summer's holiday season has started. And with that the town was readied for the festivities to commence.

The water level to the failing Alder Lake Rd. culvert has receded. Significantly slowing the road's erosion.

On Ilg Rd., a "No Thru Traffic" sign was installed. Along with that at the intersection's bike trail, STOP signs for the trail were also installed.

Mowing of town road shoulders was started towards the end of the month.

Limbing of tree branches and brushing is an ongoing project.

We received our towable high high pressure water cleaner. It will be used jointly between the Roads Dept. and the Airport.

At the Cemetery we are running an experiment with a "weed and feed" product. Right now the "Circle" was the only area of application.

Room dividers were installed at the town hall. Making it more multipurpose.

A "Mini Library" was installed for the Library on the bike trail between the Community Building and the Library.

I also need to reiterate that we need a full time Park and Rec. employee for next year. Too much time is being spent by us for garbage details and the general maintenance of the Park's lawn equipment.
