

Airport Operations Report: Nov. 2018

- 1) There were 9 plow days performed this month.
- 2) All runway lights are intact and operational.
- 3) Both gates are being kept clear of snow, and remain operational. Intend to keep gates operational throughout the winter instead of being blocked with snow or left open.
- 4) Tie Down Fees: Envelopes, Envelope holder, and signage will be posted to help assist pilots that there are tie down fees, and with envelopes, hopefully that will make it easier. Not done yet. In development.
- 5) No communications from the previous Hangar Door Apron snow removal team to either the airport or town forced airport personnel to clean up hangar door aprons after 4 days of snowfall. Issue finally resolved. Chris Messenger will be performing those duties.
- 6) Had a major issue with the yellow plow truck. Truck started up fine, but the engine stopped after 5 minutes. Changed fuel filter. Truck started, and ran another 5 minutes and stopped. Had to call in a truck mechanic to investigate problem. A cam sensor had failed. It was replaced. The mechanic noticed and reported that there was a leaking hydraulic hose while working on the truck. The hydraulic hose was changed by airport personnel.
- 7) Trained Chuck on Tractor Snow Blower on usage, guide lines, and safety tips. Chuck got some seat time clearing tall snow piles by hangars.
- 8) An FAA Ground Based Aircraft survey was performed and updated. The number of ground based aircraft was reduced from 16 to 15. We will be gaining at least one new GBA in the Spring who is currently building a new home in the area, and maybe 2 more after new hangars are completed.
