The completion of our new Salt Shed Pad and Garage approach has been done. It is now imperative that the Garden Committee rework an appropriate drainage area for our Salt Shed Pad which we have lost due to the buildup of the garden area.

During the beginning of the month at the Transfer Station we had "Clean Up Week" and it went pretty well for this year. Asides from that we are still getting a fair amount of dirt dropped off at the brush pile.....yes contractors.

Being there is no signage designating the Town Hall from the Chamber the old signage was refurbished and put in place until the new signs arrive.
