AUGUST ROAD REPORT

We are in the thick of the summer season, hot and heavy with the usual influx of urban dwellers.

The mowing of the road shoulders has basically been done. The tractor will now transition over to it's boom arm apparatus.

The shouldering of roads is still ongoing.

Trimming of tree limbs and brushing is being preformed.

The two port-o-potties and its fencing have been removed from Serbin Park. The new "drop in" toilet there has now been made operational.

At the Transfer Station another row of compost has reached maturity and also has been relocated for distribution.

Also at the Transfer Station we have been receiving an over abundance of demolished Dock/pier sections from contractors who should be taking the material directly to the County "G" landfill or in their own dumpsters as all the rest of the contractors do. The Demo dumpster and area are only for the of the town's private home owners use.

Once vacated, will the town's Fire Department Building be used for town storage and such. And yes we do need more space. And you will in the near future.
