OCTOBER ROAD REPORT

Happy October! Our first official plowing was on 10/21 along with a few road scrapings and sandings there after.

Portions of Alder Lake Rd. and Circle Lily roads have been prepped for paving.

The 3rd and last phase of total new signs replacement project has been started.

200 cu. Yards of winter sand has been received along with salt. It has been mixed in with our 300 plus yards of our existing stock pile.

Our John Deere 6330 tractor needed to be sent out to Serwe Implements for a proper repair job. At this point time of completion is unknown yet.

A new Road Department Duties Worksheet has been submitted.

We have begun to convert the Garage's shop lights over to LED type.

The old Fire Department's building has now become a much needed storage area for town use. Our pontoon boat has already found a home there.

Brand new 30 foot flag poles have now been installed at the Community Building and at Koller Park replacing the old and antiquated ones.

The Playground and the Koller Park bathrooms have been drained and winterized.

A buoy condition inventory of the Chain was submitted for evaluation.

At the Transfer Station the commercial chipping of our brush pile has begun.
